Make your own re-usable gift bag

Congratulations on joining the re-use movement and making your own re-usable gift bag.

Your instructions:

Take your pre-cut recycled fabric and fold it in half with right sides together.



Stitch both sides together using a 1.5cm seam allowance. Reverse at the beginning and end of the stitching on both sides to stop them from unraveling.



Leave the bag inside out and iron the top edge over 1cm towards the wrong side, keeping side seams open.



Iron the top edge again towards the wrong side, 2cm this time.



Measure the middle of one side of the bag equal distance from each side seam. This will be the position of the hole for the ribbon to come out.



Stitch around the 'folded over' top edge about 2mm from the edge leaving a hole approximately 3cm across. Reverse at the beginning and end of the stitching. This forms the casing for ribbon.



Secure the safety pin through a double layer of the ribbon at one end.



Thread the ribbon through the casing, taking care to leave a reasonable length showing at the entry hole.



Once you get to the other hole, pull the ends of the ribbon gently to make them even and then tie the ends together.



Fill with treats, tie the ribbon and enjoy.



- Attach a label to the bag to show the recipient's name.
- Add a piece of shell to the ribbon.
- Use Velcro or a button at the top and fold over, instead of ribbon to close it.
